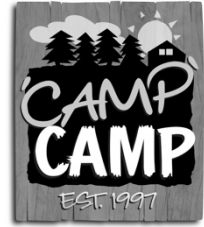


crafts: chainmaille supply list



1. Two pairs of jewelry pliers (no teeth/texture inside the jaws). You can get both needed right here: https://smile.amazon.com/Artistic-Wire-Chain-Pliers-Piece/dp/B004F9Q7RC/ref=sr_1_3?dchild=1&keywords=artistic+wire+pliers&qid=1597367805&sr=8-3
2. 1/2 ounce of rings will be enough for 1-3 bracelets. Get more if you think you might want to make more things! <https://weavegotmaille.com/18-awg-bright-aluminum-jump-rings/>
- Important: From the drop down, select "5.5mm (7/32)" – 668 RPO"
3. To make your bracelet wearable, you'll also need a clasp which you'll find in the Findings section of the website directly above. Instructor Amy Putnam uses lobster clasps, and the site has [some neat options](#).
